**Report on the Audit of Annual Financial Results**

**Opinion**

We have audited the accompanying Annual Financial Results of **Solitaire Machine Tools Limited** (hereinafter referred to as the "Company") for the year ended March 31, 2025, attached herewith, being submitted by the Company pursuant to the requirement of Regulation 33 of the Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended ("Listing Regulations").

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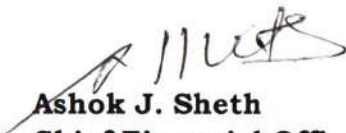
